Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities

Eligibility

An applicant must -

- ❖ Belong to the minority community (Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Jain, and Zoroastrian/ Parsi)
- ❖ Be studying in graduate, postgraduate, technical or vocational courses, M.Phil. Or Ph.D. Degree
- ❖ Have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grades in the previous final examination
- ❖ Have an annual family income of less than INR 2.5 lakhs from all the sources

Merit Cum Means Scholarship for Professional and Technical Courses CS (Minorities)

Eligibility

An applicant must -

- ❖ Belong to the minority community (Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, jain, and Zoroastrian/Parsi)
- ❖ Be studying in class 11,12, graduate, postgraduate, technical or vocational courses, M.Phil. Or Ph.D. Degree
- ❖ Have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grades in the previous final examination
- ❖ Have an annual family income of less than INR 2.5 lakhs from all the sources

- ❖ The selected candidates will receive the scholarship in the following way -
- * Rate of Scholarship Course Fees INR 20,000 per annum subject to actual whichever is less (For both Hosteller and Day Scholar)
- **❖ Maintenance Allowance** INR 1,000 per month for 10 months for Hostellers
- ❖ INR 500 per month for 10 months for Day Scholars

Central Sector Scheme Of Scholarship For College And University Students Eligibility

- Be above the 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream in Class 12 or equivalent of respective state examination boards
- Be pursuing a regular course such as Medical and Engineering in a college/institution recognized by the AICTE, Dental Council of India (DCI), Medical Council of India (MCI), and other respective regulatory authorities
- Have annual family income not more than INR 8 lakh from all sources
- Not be in receipt of any other scholarship

- **Benefits**: The students selected for this scholarship are provided financial support which varies depending on their education level.
- At the Graduation Level A scholarship of INR 10,000 per annum will be provided for the first three years.
- At the Post graduation Level An amount of INR 20,000 per annum will be provided.
- For 5-year Professional Courses INR 20,000 per annum will be provided in the 4th and 5th year.

Financial Assistance for Education of the Wards of Beedi/Cine/IOMC/LSDM Workers - Post-Matric

Eligibility:

- Either of the parents of the students should be Beedi, Iron Ore Manganese & Chrome Ore Mines, Limestone & Dolomite Mines, Cine worker with at least six months service. This also includes Contract/Gharkhata (Home Based) workers also.
- Professional Course: Rs. 25,000

PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS (TECHNICAL DEGREE)

• ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) The girl candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree level course OR Second year of Degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Maximum two girl child per family are eligible.
- 3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/ UT Government need to be enclosed.

- The selection of candidate will be carried out solely on the basis of merit of qualifying examination to peruse the Technical Degree course from any of the AICTE approved institutions i.e. in First year or Second year (through lateral entry only) on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the 10+2/equivalent examination
- Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study i.e. maximum 4 years for first year admitted students and maximum 3 years for second year admitted students through lateral entry

SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SPECIALLY ABLED STUDENT (TECHNICAL DEGREE)

- 1)The candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree level course OR Second year of Degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Specially-abled student, having disability of not less than 40%.
- 3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State /UT Government need to be enclosed.

AICTE – SWANATH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (TECHNICAL DEGREE)

- ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:
- 1) The candidate should be from any one of the following categories:
- (i) Orphan

OR

(ii) Either or both parents died due to Covid 19

OR

- (iii) Wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed)
- 2) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the financial year of the application.
- 3) The candidate should be currently studying in the AICTE Approved institutions and courses at Degree/ Diploma level in regular mode (in 1st /2nd / 3rd /4th year).
- Rs. 50,000.00 per annum for every year of study i.e. maximum 4 years duration for first year admitted Degree students

State Merit Scholarship (SMS)

- Eligibility
- To be eligible, an applicant must:
- Be a first-year student of Undergraduate or Postgraduate course in Govt/Aided colleges or University Departments
- Be a native of Kerala
- Have scored 50% or above in the qualifying examination.
- Have an annual family income not exceeding INR 1 lakh

- Benefits
- The selected students will receive the following benefits:
- INR 1,250 per annum to 300 Graduate students
- INR 1,500 per annum to 150 Postgraduate students

CH Muhammed Koya Scholarship

C H Muhammedkoya Scholarship Eligibility Details

Scholarships Amount

Under Graduates: Rs. 5,000/Year Post Graduates: Rs. 6,000/Year Professional Courses: Rs. 7,000/Year Hostel Stipend: Rs. 13,000/Year

Eligibility Conditions:

- Should belong to Muslim, Latin, Converted Christian community and should be a native of Kerala.
- Should be a GIRL student studying for Graduation or Higher courses in Govt./ Aided Institution.
- 3. Students who got admission to Self financing colleges from merit seat are also eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- 4. Should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying Examination.
- 5. Family Annual income should not exceed 8 Lakhs.
- Those who apply for Hostel stipend should be staying in recognized hostels.THOSE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR HOSTEL STIPEND WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR
- THOSE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR HOSTEL STIPEND WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIP.

Suvarna Jubilee Merit Scholarship

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Be a native of Kerala
- Be studying in the first year of undergraduate or postgraduate course in Govt/Aided colleges or University Departments
- Belong to the BPL family
- Have scored 50% or above in the qualifying examination

Benefits

• The selected students will get a scholarship of INR 10,000 per annum for the duration of their course.

- A student shall be eligible for only one scholarship out of all the available Scholarships of Central Government meant for SC/ST/OBC/ minority
- Scholarship will not be given to more than two students from a family (applicable for all Scholarship schemes meant for minorities under this Ministry taken together).

Vidya Samunnathi Scholarship


- You should be a native of the Kerala State.
- Applicants should be from the non-reservation forward community.
- The annual income of the student's family should be less than Rs
 2 lacs from all sources.
- Apart from that, candidates need to produce their Aadhaar Card, Address Proof, and Bank Account Passbook details for www.kswcfc.org 2022 eligibility.

The list of documents to be uploaded for both Fresh & Renewal Scholarships under Merit cum Means based scholarship scheme

- i. Student Photo. (Mandatory)
- ii. Institution Verification Form. A copy of form is annexed. (Mandatory)
- iii. Income Certificate: Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the State/UT Government is required (Mandatory).
- iv. Religion Certificate: Self Declaration/Certification or Self Attested Community Certificate (Mandatory).
- v. Mark sheet: (a) In case of Fresh: Self-Attested Certificate of 'Previous Qualifying Exam /Board Marksheet' as filled in the Form. (Mandatory).
 - (b) In case of Renewal: Self-Attested Certificate of Previous Year /Last exam passed Marksheet (for same/ongoing course) as filled in the Form. (Mandatory).
- vi. Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year'. (Mandatory)
- vii. Proof of Bank Account in the name of Student. (Mandatory).
- viii. Residential/Domicile Certificate (Mandatory).



SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Fresh As the number of scholarships for minorities available in a year is fixed and limited, it is necessary to lay down preference for selection. Inter-se selection weightage is to be given to poverty rather than marks (the applicant is required to submit an income certificate as per para-11(ii)). In case of same income, merit shall be generated from 'Date of Birth' criteria of applicant (senior is preferred).
- Renewal There is no merit list generation for renewal cases. Renewal applicant will get the scholarship if one has obtained 50% in his/her previous year's examinations (at the same institute and in same course) and his/her application is verified by all authorities (as designated by Ministry of Minority Affairs) and approved by State Governments/UTs.
